13	(a) a motor vehicle manufactured before July 1, 1966;
14	(b) a motor vehicle in which the driver or passengers possess a written verification from
15	a licensed physician that the driver or passenger is unable to wear a safety belt for physical or
16	medical reasons; or
17	(c) a motor vehicle or seating position which is not required to be equipped with a safety
18	belt system under federal law.
19	(2) This article does not apply to a passenger who is an immediate family member, as
20	defined in Section 76-5-106.5, of the driver if all seating positions are occupied by other
21	passengers.
