14	Notwithstanding any other provision of this part, a municipal legislative body may not
15	approve an annexation petition under this part which involves the annexation of territory included
16	within a township unless the annexation:
17	(1) includes the entire area of the township; or
18	(2) has been approved by:
19	(a) the township planning commission; or
20	(b) a majority of the voters residing within the township in a special election called for that
21	purpose.
