5	This act modifies the Utah State Retirement Act by providing a conversion window between

12	Section 1. Section 49-3-205 is amended to read:
13	49-3-205. Conversion to system Time schedule.
14	The following laws govern conversion to the Public Employees' Noncontributory
15	Retirement System:
16	(1) For persons governed by Subsection 49-3-203 (2), the election to participate in the
17	noncontributory system shall be made within six months of the effective date of this chapter.
18	(2) (a) For political subdivisions governed by Subsection 49-3-203 (3), the election to
19	participate as a local government unit shall be made within six months of the effective date of this
20	chapter. The political subdivision shall indicate whether or not it elects to participate by enacting
21	a resolution or ordinance to that effect. Prior to the enactment of the resolution or ordinance, a
22	hearing shall be held by the political subdivision, at which all employees of the political
23	subdivision shall be given an opportunity to be heard on the question of participating in this
24	noncontributory retirement system. Notice of the hearing shall be mailed to all employees within
25	30 days of the hearing and shall contain the time, place, and purpose of the hearing.
26	(b) A person in full-time employment with a political subdivision prior to its election to
27	participate has six months from the date the political subdivision elects to participate in which to



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28	elect to become a member of the noncontributory system.
29	(3) Subsections (1) and (2) shall be used to provide a second time period of conversion to
30	this system beginning July 1, 1990.

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(4) Subsections (1) and (2) shall be used to provide a third time period of conversion to this system beginning July 1, 1995.

(5) Subsections (1) and (2) shall be used to provide a fourth time period of conversion to this system beginning July 1, 2002.
