10 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

11 Section 1. Section **71-3-1** is amended to read:

12 **71-3-1. Use of armories by veterans' organizations permitted.**

Under [such regulations as the state armory board may prescribe, any organization of veterans of the Civil War, the war with Spain or the World War] regulations prescribed by the state armory board, any federally chartered veterans' organization shall have the right to the free use of armories owned or leased by the state; provided[, such] that the use [shall] does not interfere with the use of the [same] armories by the national guard or organized militia of this state.
