17	(1) The division shall establish criteria for a bow hunter education course, which may be
18	offered by any entity that meets the division's criteria.
19	(2) The bow hunter education course shall include instruction in:
20	(a) the safe use of bow hunting equipment;
21	(b) fundamentals of bow hunting;
22	(c) shooting and hunting techniques; and
23	(d) hunter ethics.
24	(3) The division shall issue a certificate of completion to a participant upon successful
25	completion of a bow hunter education course which meets the requirements of this section and
26	criteria established by the division.
27	(4) The Wildlife Board may make the successful completion of a state or nationally



28	recognized bow hunter education course a prerequisite to obtaining specified types of archery
29	permits.
30	(5) The Wildlife Board may make rules to implement Subsection (4) in accordance with
31	Title 63, Chapter 46a, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act.

33	23-19-13. Hunter, bow hunter, and furharvester education training Fee.
34	The Wildlife Board shall establish the fees to be assessed for obtaining instruction in hunter
