

**RESOLUTION CHANGING SENATE
COMMITTEE NAMES**

2002 GENERAL SESSION

This resolution modifies the Senate Rules changing standing committee names to bring them into greater coordination with the interim structure. This Senate resolution provides an effective date.

This resolution affects legislative rules as follows:

AMENDS:

SR-24.05

Be it resolved by the Senate of the state of Utah:

Section 1. **SR-24.05** is amended to read:

SR-24.05. Standing Committees.

(1) The President shall appoint the following standing committees:

(a) Business[;] and Labor[~~;-and Economic Development~~];

(b) Education;

(c) Government Operations and Political Subdivisions;

(d) Health and [~~Environment~~] Human Services;

~~[(e) Human Services;]~~

~~[(f)]~~ (e) Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice;

~~[(c) Energy;]~~ (f) Natural Resources, [and] Agriculture, and Environment;

(g) Revenue and Taxation;

(h) Senate Rules;

~~[(i) State and Local Affairs; and]~~

~~[(j)]~~ (i) Transportation [and Public Safety;] and Public Utilities and Technology; and

(j) Workforce Services and Community and Economic Development.

(2) The members of the Legislative Quasi-Governmental Entities Committee created in Section 63-95-201 appointed from the Senate constitute a standing committee.

Section 2. **Effective date.**

This resolution takes effect upon approval by a constitutional majority vote of all members of the Senate with an implementation date of January 1, 2003.
