21	[(c)] (a) Hyrum Dam;
22	[(d)] <u>(b)</u> Avon;
23	[(e)] <u>(c)</u> Mill Creek;
24	[(f)] <u>(d)</u> Oneida Narrows; and
25	[(g)] <u>(e)</u> North Eden Creek.
26	(3) The division may develop sites other than those listed in Subsection (2) if those
27	projects are authorized and funded by the Legislature.
