15	scale. Employees working three sessions for the Legislature may be paid under the "Step 3" scale.											
16	Employees working four sessions for the Legislature may be paid under the "Step 4" scale.											
17	Employees working five or more sessions for the Legislature may be paid under the "Step 5" scale.											
18	Senate employees are designated with an "S". House of Representative employees are
