Representative Swallow requested that a member of the committee make a motion to adopt 1<sup>st</sup> Substitute H.B. 82.

The motion failed 3-6-4, with Representatives Arent, Daniels, and Hendrickson voting in favor of the motion, Representatives Bennion, Bryson, Ferry, Thompson, Ferrin and Way voting in opposition to the motion, and Representatives Bigelow and Tyler absent for the vote.
