## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATURE TO CALL ITSELF INTO SPECIAL SESSION

Representative **Greg J. Curtis** proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 1, Line 1: After "**RESOLUTION**" delete "**AUTHORIZING THE**" and insert "**ON SPECIAL SESSIONS OF THE LEGISLATURE**"
2. Page 1, Lines 2-3: Delete lines 2 and 3
3. Page 1, Line 11: After "Governor." insert "The joint resolution requires advance notice of legislative business in a special session called by either the Governor or Legislature, with certain exceptions. The joint resolution prohibits a special session to be convened by the Legislature within a specified period after an annual general session."
4. Page 2, Line 34: After "(1)" insert "(a)"
5. Page 2, Line 36: After "special session" delete ", as provided in"
6. Page 2, Line 37: At the beginning of line 37 delete "Subsection (2)."
7. Page 2, Line 39: After line 39 insert:  
  
"(b) The Legislature may not transact any legislative business in a special session convened under this section for which it has not provided 48 hours advance public notice, except in cases of emergency."
8. Page 2, Line 43: After line 43 insert:  
  
"(3) No special session of the Legislature may be convened under this section until 60 days after the adjournment sine die of the annual general session of the Legislature."

9. Page 2, Line 46: At the beginning of line 46 insert "(1)(a)"
10. Page 2, Line 47: After "convened, and it" bracket "shall" and insert "may"
11. Page 2, Line 48: After "convened, or" reinstate "such" and delete "while"
12. Page 2, Line 49: At the beginning of line 49 delete "in session"
13. Page 2, Line 51: After "thereto." insert:
- "(b) The Legislature may not transact any legislative business in a special session convened under this section for which the Governor has not provided 48 hours advance public notice, except in cases of emergency or with the concurrence of two-thirds of all members elected to each house.
