

**REPEAL OF SUNSET DATE FOR
LIMITATIONS ON ANNEXING TOWNSHIP**

2003 GENERAL SESSION

This act repeals a sunset provision that would have eliminated in 2006 a prohibition against a municipality in a first class county from approving an annexation petition for an area within a township unless the entire township were annexed or unless the annexation were approved by voters or property owners.

This act affects sections of Utah Code Annotated 1953 as follows:
