15	(1) As used in this section:		
16	(a) "Children" includes stepchildren and legally adopted children.		
17	(b) "Line-of-duty death" means a death resulting from external force or violence		
18	occasioned by an act of duty as an employee.		
19	(2) The beneficiary of a covered individual who is employed by the state and who [dies		
20	in the line of duty] has a line-of-duty death shall receive:		
21	(a) the proceeds of a $\$50,000$ group term life insurance policy [in the amount of		
22	\$50,000 to be purchased by the program and] paid for by the state and administered and		
23	provided as part of the group life insurance program under this chapter; and		
24	(b) group health coverage paid for by the state that covers the covered individual's:		
25	(i) surviving spouse until remarriage or becoming eligible for Medicare, whichever		
26	comes first; and		
27	(ii) unmarried children up to the age of 26.

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## 28 (3) Any covered employer may provide the benefit under Subsection (2).

- 29 (4) The benefit provided under Subsection (2)(a) is subject to the same terms and
- 30 <u>conditions as the group life insurance program provided under this chapter.</u>

### 31 Section 2. Effective date.

- 32 If approved by two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, this act takes effect
- 33 upon approval by the governor, or the day following the constitutional time limit of Utah
- 34 <u>Constitution Article VII, Section 8, without the governor's signature, or in the case of a veto,</u>
- 35 <u>the date of veto override.</u>
