11	2003.

16	Section 1. Section <b>13-8-6</b> is enacted to read:
17	<b><u>13-8-6.</u></b> Waiver of right to damages for unreasonable delay prohibited.
18	(1) A party to a construction contract, as defined in Section 13-8-5, may seek recovery
19	for damages or an equitable adjustment arising out of an unreasonable delay in performance
20	caused by an act or omission or another party to the contract, or a person acting for that party,
21	when the provisions of the construction contract allow at least one party to recover damages for
22	<u>delay.</u>
23	(2) This section shall not apply to construction contracts for construction of a residence
24	as defined in Section 38-11-102.
25	(3) This section applies only to construction contracts entered on or after July 1, 2003.
