

Representative Scott Daniels proposes the following substitute bill:

1 **RESOLUTION URGING THE PRESIDENT TO USE**
2 **THE UNITED NATIONS TO RESOLVE CONFLICT WITH IRAQ**

3 2003 GENERAL SESSION

4 STATE OF UTAH

5 **Sponsor: Don E. Bush**

6 **This resolution of the House of Representatives urges the President of the United States**
7 **to use the United Nations and other diplomatic means to resolve the conflict with Iraq.**

8 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the state of Utah:*

9 WHEREAS, the United Nations was established in an attempt to prevent future
10 generations from having to suffer the horrors of war;

11 WHEREAS, the United Nations provides a mechanism for the international community
12 to respond to aggression and terrorism;

13 WHEREAS, the United States of America is considering pre-emptive use of force in
14 Iraq;

15 WHEREAS, Iraq is a nation of 23 million people, including 12 million children;

16 WHEREAS, hundreds of thousands of innocent civilians as well as military troops will
17 likely be seriously injured or killed if a United States invasion should take place;

18 WHEREAS, war is a terrible solution to the problems of Iraq and may even serve to
19 hasten the use or proliferation of weapons of mass destruction; and

20 WHEREAS, a pre-emptive attack may create a hostile and destabilizing response
21 among the international community, particularly the Arab nations:

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
23 state of Utah respectfully urge the President of the United States to resolve the conflict with
24 Iraq through means of diplomacy using, among other tools, the United Nations, and not
25 through violence and war.



26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the President of
27 the United States and to the members of Utah's congressional delegation.
