10                   **SR-24.05**

11   *Be it resolved by the Senate of the state of Utah:*

12                   Section 1. **SR-24.05** is amended to read:

13                   **SR-24.05. Standing Committees.**

14                   (1) The President shall appoint the following standing committees:

15                   (a) Business and Labor;

16                   (b) Education;

17                   (c) Government Operations and Political Subdivisions;

18                   (d) Health and Human Services;

19                   (e) Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice;

20                   (f) Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment;

21                   (g) Revenue and Taxation;

22                   (h) Senate Rules;

23                   (i) Transportation and Public Utilities and Technology; and

24                   (j) Workforce Services and Community and Economic Development.

25                   (2) The members of the [~~Legislative Quasi-Governmental~~] Retirement and Independent  
26   Entities Committee created in Section [~~63-95-201~~] 63E-1-201 who are appointed from the  
27   Senate [~~constitute~~] are a standing committee.



28           Section 2. **Effective date.**  
29           This resolution takes effect upon approval by a constitutional majority vote of all  
30 members of the Senate.
