Chair Bryson called the meeting to order at 7:05 a.m.

MOTION: Rep. Ferry moved to approve the minutes of the February 24, 2003 meeting. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Buttars, and Rep. S. Clark absent for the vote.

S.B. 120 Payment of Wages Amendments (*S. Jenkins*)

Sen. Jenkins explained the bill with the assistance of Joseph Gallegos Jr., Director, Anti-Discrimination Division, Utah Labor Commission.

MOTION: Rep. Adams moved to pass the bill out favorably. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Buttars, and Rep. S. Clark absent for the vote.

2nd Sub. S.B. 62 Utah House Inspection Standard of Practice (*P. Julander*)

Sen. Julander explained the bill with the assistance of Ted Johnson, owner, Amerispec Inspection Company.

2nd Sub. S.B. 89 Mental Health Professional Practice Act Amendments (D. C. Buttars)

S.B. 198 Division of Real Estate - Definitions Amendments (J. Valentine)

1st Sub. S.B. 153 Alcoholic Beverage Amendments (J. Valentine)

S.B. 157 Regulation of Credit Union Service Organizations (L. Hillyard)

Sen. Hillyard explained the bill with the assistance of Ed Leary, Commissioner of Financial Institutions.

MOTION: Rep. Morley moved to pass the bill out favorably. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Biskupski, and Rep. S. Clark absent for the vote.

MOTION: Rep. Adams moved to move **H.B. 271 Airport to University of Utah Light Rail Restricted Account Amendments (*D.Ure*)** next on the agenda. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Biskupski, and Rep. S. Clark absent for the vote.

MOTION: Rep. Adams moved to table the bill.

Committee discussion followed.

Rep. D. Clark moved previous question. The motion to cut off debate passed unanimously, with Rep. Biskupski, and Rep. S. Clark absent for the vote.

The motion to table passed, with Rep. Bryson, Rep. Duckworth, Rep. Hansen, and Rep. Parker voting in opposition.

S.B. 66 Alcoholic Beverage Enforcement and Treatment (*M. Waddoups*)

Sen. Waddoups explained the bill.
