**H.B. 102      Election Day Materials (*L. Pace*)**

Rep. Pace introduced H.B. 102 and explained it to the committee.

Rep. Ferrin relinquished the chair to Rep. Hutchings.

Spoke in favor of the bill:      Olene Walker, Lieutenant Governor

**H.B. 103      Voter Registration Amendments (*L. Pace*)**

**H.B. 215 State Agency - Lobbyist Restriction Amendments (*W. Harper*)**

**H.J.R. 16 Resolution Regarding the Collection and Retention of Personal Information by Government Entities (*W. Harper*)**

Page 2, Line 36: After “has been” delete “recorded” and insert “collected”
