MOTION: Rep. Parker moved to approve the minutes of the February 12, 2003 meeting. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Christensen, Rep. Harper, Rep. Morley, and Rep. Wallace absent for the vote.

H.B. 334 Enticing Minors over Internet Amendments (D. Bourdeaux)

MOTION: Rep. Bourdeaux moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1, Line 6: Delete "**amending the offense of enticing a minor over the**"
2. Page 1, Line 7: Delete entire line
3. Page 1, Line 8: Delete entire line and insert "**eliminating an unnecessary reference to other criminal code provisions.**"
4. Page 1, Line 17: After "attempts to" insert "use a computer to"
