(b) the definition of "service center" which is deleted in S.B. 157

Subsection 7-9-3(10) of this bill takes effect on May 3, 2004; and
(c) Subsection 7-9-5(12) in this bill supersedes Subsection
7-9-5(12) in S.B. 157 when this section takes effect on May 3, 2004."
