LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill amends provisions relating to grazing permit fees on school and institutional trust lands and the purposes for which those fees are used.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ amends provisions relating to grazing permit fees to increase the fee per animal unit month (AUM); and
- ▶ allows the fees to be used for insect and disease infestations on school and institutional trust lands.

53C-5-104, as last amended by Chapter 256, Laws of Utah 2002

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **53C-5-104** is amended to read:

53C-5-104. Fees.

(1) The director shall collect a fee annually from each grazing permittee for the control of noxious weeds [~~and~~], new and invading plant species, insects, and disease infestations on trust [~~lands~~] rangelands.

(2) The fee shall be [~~5~~] 10 cents per animal unit month (AUM).

(3) Fees collected by the director under this section shall be deposited in the Land Grant Management Fund created in Section 53C-3-101 and shall be used by the director for the payment of costs incurred in controlling noxious weeds [~~and~~], new and invading plant species, insects, and disease infestations on school and institutional trust lands.
