8                   **General Description:**

9                   This bill amends the State System of Public Education.

10                   **Highlighted Provisions:**

11                   This bill:

- 12                   ▶ limits the type of foods that may be sold by an elementary school from a vending  
13 machine accessible to students; and  
14                   ▶ provides a delayed implementation of vending machine requirements.

23                   *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

24                   Section 1. Section **53A-15-1001** is enacted to read:

25   **Part 10. Promoting Nutrition**



26            **53A-15-1001. Vending machines.**

27            (1) After the date specified in Subsection (2), an elementary school may not sell, or  
28 allow to be sold, through vending machines on premises accessible to students food products  
29 other than water, milk, 100% fruit juice, or fresh fruit.

30            (2) The requirements of Subsection (1) shall be met upon the first to occur of the  
31 following:

32            (a) the natural expiration or earlier termination of a school's contracts in force with  
33 vending machine suppliers; or

34            (b) May 5, 2006.
