7 **LONG TITLE**

8 **General Description:**

9 This bill modifies the State Officers and Employees Code by requiring the Division of
10 Finance to disclose certain dollar amounts relating to compensation and benefit costs to
11 employees.

12 **Highlighted Provisions:**

13 This bill:

14 ▶ requires the Division of Finance to annually disclose to all state employees the costs
15 of compensation and benefits that are paid by the state.

16 **Monies Appropriated in this Bill:**

18 **Other Special Clauses:**

19 This bill takes effect on July 1, 2004.

21 ENACTS:

22 **67-19-42**, Utah Code Annotated 1953

24 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

25 Section 1. Section **67-19-42** is enacted to read:

26 **67-19-42. Employee cost disclosure.**

27 The Division of Finance shall, at least annually, plainly disclose to all state employees



28 the costs of compensation and benefits that are paid by the state in dollar figures.

29 Section 2. **Effective date.**

30 This bill takes effect on July 1, 2004.
