**JOINT RULES RESOLUTION -
APPROPRIATION SUBCOMMITTEE MEETINGS**

2004 GENERAL SESSION

LONG TITLE

General Description:

This resolution requires that appropriations subcommittees meet monthly during the interim.

Highlighted Provisions:

This resolution:

- ▶ requires that appropriations subcommittees meet monthly from April through November;
- ▶ directs the Legislative Management Committee to set the date each month when they will meet; and
- ▶ establishes duties and responsibilities of the appropriations subcommittees during the interim.

Special Clauses:

This resolution takes effect immediately.

Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah:



26 Section 1. **JR-3.05** is amended to read:

27 **JR-3.05. Appropriation Subcommittee Meetings.**

28 (1) In addition to the regular interim committees, appropriation subcommittees shall
29 [also] meet [as] each month from April through November on the date determined by the
30 Legislative Management Committee.

31 (2) During each interim, each appropriation subcommittee shall:

32 (a) schedule and conduct a review of agencies or programs for which the appropriation
33 subcommittee makes budget recommendations to the Executive Appropriations Committee;

34 (b) make recommendations to the Legislative Fiscal Analyst and the Executive
35 Appropriations Committee about agency or program budgets;

36 (c) make recommendations to the persons responsible for agency or program budgets
37 about increasing efficiencies, saving government monies, and making agency programs more
38 effective; and

39 (d) perform other budget review and oversight responsibilities as directed by the
40 Executive Appropriations Committee, the subcommittee chair, and the subcommittee.

41 **Section 2. Effective date.**

42 This resolution takes effect upon approval by a constitutional majority vote of all
43 members of the Senate and House of Representatives.
