WHEREAS, on any given night between 2,000 and 3,000 people in Utah experience	
homeles	sness;
V	WHEREAS, these homeless families and individuals are forced to live in homeless
shelters,	domestic violence shelters, under viaducts, in their cars, along rivers, in the woods and



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28	in caves, or doubled up involuntarily in others' homes;
29	WHEREAS, over the course of the 2001-02 school year, 8,500 school-aged children in
30	Utah experienced homelessness;
31	WHEREAS, approximately 1,500 of Utah's homeless are chronically homeless,
32	meaning that they are individuals who have been homeless for at least a year and have a
33	disabling physical condition or mental illness;
34	WHEREAS, 35% of homeless people work but do not earn enough to afford housing,
35	child care, and transportation;
36	WHEREAS, 16% of Utah's homeless are veterans;
37	WHEREAS, well-documented and effective solutions to end chronic homelessness
38	exist and could be implemented in Utah with adequate funding; and
39	WHEREAS, President Bush has launched an initiative, referred to as the Samaritan
40	Initiative, to end chronic homelessness:
