22	Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah:		
23	WHEREAS, motor homes are subject to statewide uniform fees in lieu of property		
24	taxes;		
25	WHEREAS, the statewide uniform fees on motor homes in some cases may exceed the		
26	amount of property taxes a person is required to pay on that person's residence;		
27	WHEREAS, some motor home owners may in violation of Utah law register their		



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28	motor nomes in other states to avoid Utan's statewide uniform fees;	
29	WHEREAS, motor homes are used throughout the state to enjoy Utah's recreational	
30	opportunities;	
31	WHEREAS, it is important to ensure affordable recreational opportunities for Utah's	
32	citizens;	
33	WHEREAS, there exists within the state tax structure several classes of tangible	
34	personal property that are subject to different statewide uniform fees; and	
35	WHEREAS, motor homes should constitute a separate class of tangible personal	
36	property with a statewide uniform fee that applies exclusively to motor homes:	
37	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah	
38	urges the Revenue and Taxation Interim Committee to study during the 2004 Interim:	
39	(1) creating a statewide uniform fee that applies exclusively to motor homes, such as a	
40	statewide uniform fee imposed on the basis of the length of the motor home; and	
41	(2) issues relating to implementing a statewide uniform fee on motor homes.	
42	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Revenue and Taxation Interim Committee	
43	should invite testimony on this issue from interested parties including:	
44	(1) owners of motor homes;	
45	(2) representatives of the motor home industry;	
46	(3) local government officials; and	
47	(4) the State Tax Commission.
