This bill provides that a marriage license issued in Utah may only be used in Utah.

30-1-7, as last amended by Chapter 246, Laws of Utah 1987

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **30-1-7** is amended to read:

30-1-7. Marriage licenses -- Use within state -- Expiration.

- (1) No marriage may be solemnized <u>in this state</u> without a license issued by the county clerk of any county of [the] <u>this</u> state [of Utah not more than 30 days prior to the date of solemnization of the marriage].
- (2) A license issued within this state by a county clerk may only be used within this state.

(3) A license that is not used within 30 days of the date of issuance is void.
