The Judiciary Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 7**, MARRIAGE PREPARATION EDUCATION, by Representative R. McGee, with the following amendments:

1. Page 2, Lines 56 through 58

(ii) The fee authorized by this Subsection (2) (b) shall be waived if the requirements of Section 30-1-34 are met. If the fee is waived, the county is not required to transmit \$20 of the marriage license fee to the Division of Finance.

2. Page 3, Line 88 through Page 4, Line 93

(i) a licensed or ordained minister or the

(ii) a person authorized to solemnize marriages under [[-Section-]] Subsection
