Mr. Speaker:

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 39**, SPECIAL FUNCTIONS OFFICERS FOR THE DIVISION OF OCCUPATIONAL AND PROFESSIONAL LICENSING, by Representative J. M. Philpot, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 31 through 33:*

- 31           (2) An investigator employed under Subsection (1) is a special function officer, as  
32 defined in Section 53-13-105, but is not eligible for retirement benefits under the Public  
          Safety  
33 Noncontributory Retirement System.

**(3)(a) It is not the intent of the Legislature to designate the division as an agency whose primary purpose would be that of general law enforcement.**

**(b) The primary purpose of the division is to administer and enforce the provisions of Title 58, Occupations and Professions.**
