Mr. Speaker:

The Workforce Services and Community and Economic Development Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 75**, INDUSTRIAL ASSISTANCE FUND AMENDMENTS, by Representative D. Clark, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 4, Lines 100 through 112:
 - 100 (ii) The value of the credits described in Subsection (3)(a)(i) shall be based on factors
 - 101 determined by the administrator, including:
 - 102 (A) the number of Utah jobs created;
 - 103 (B) the increased economic activity in Utah; [[-and-]] <u>or</u>
 - 104 (C) other events and activities that occur as a result of the fund assistance.
 - 105 (b) (i) The administrator shall provide for a system of credits to be used to support
 - 106 grant payments or in lieu of cash repayment of a fund loan when loans are made to a company
 - 107 creating an economic impediment.
 - 108 (ii) The value of the credits described in Subsection (3)(b)(i) shall be based on factors
 - 109 determined by the administrator, including:
 - 110 (A) the number of Utah jobs created;
 - 111 (B) the increased economic activity in Utah; [[-and-]] <u>or</u>
 - 112 (C) other events and activities that occur as a result of the fund assistance.
