Mr. Speaker:

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on H.B. 152, CHARTER

SCHOOL GOVERNANCE, by Representative M. Dillree, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Line 16:
- authorize and promote the establishment of charter schools <u>subject to</u>
 <u>approval of the State Board of Education</u>; and
- 2. Page 1, Lines 21 through 22:
 - 21 [[→ removes the State Board of Education's power to authorize the establishment of new
 - 22 charter schools;]]
- 3. Page 4, Lines 100 through 102:
 - 100 (1) The State Charter School Board shall:
 - 101 (a) authorize and promote the establishment of charter schools, subject to the
 - 102 limitations in [[Section]] Sections 53A-1a-502 and 53A-1a-505 ;
- 4. Page 8, Lines 227 through 231:
 - 227 [(c)] (d) The State [Board of Education] Charter School Board shall review and, by
 - 228 majority vote, either approve or deny the application within 60 days after the application is
 - received by the board.

(e) The State Board of Education shall, by majority vote, within 60 days after
 action by the State Charter School Board under Subsection (1)(d):
 (i) approve or deny an application approved by the State Charter School Board; or
 (ii) hear an appeal, if any, of an application denied by the State Charter School
 Board.

- 230 [(d)] [[(-(e)]] (<u>f</u>) The [state board's] <u>State</u> [[-<u>Charter School</u>]] <u>Board</u> of <u>Education's</u> action under Subsection
- 231 [(2)(c)] (1) [[(d)]] (e) is final action subject to judicial review.
- 5. Page 10, Line 297 through Page 11, Line 307
 - 297 [[-<u>(o) a statement indicating whether the school will seek accreditation and, if so,</u> <u>the</u>
 - 298 standards or accrediting body under which the school will seek accreditation;
 - **299** (p)] (0) the school's intention to create a library;

371	(3) (a) Except as provided in Subsection (3)(b), State Board of Education rules
372	overning the following do not apply to a charter school:

374	[[<u>(ii)</u>]] <u>(i)</u> <u>school libraries;</u>
375	[[<u>(iii)</u>]] <u>(ii)</u> required school administrative and supervisory services; and
376	[[<u>(iv)</u>]] <u>(iii)</u> required expenditures for instructional supplies.

- 412 (a) Chapter 8, Utah Orderly School Termination Procedures Act;
- 413 (b) Chapter 10, Educator Evaluation; and
- 414 (c) Title 52, Chapter 3, Prohibiting Employment of Relatives [[; and
- 415 (d) Title 67, Chapter 16, Public Officers' and Employees' Ethics Act]] .
