The Judiciary Committee recommends **H.B. 262**, PENALTIES FOR PROVIDING FALSE OR MISLEADING INFORMATION IN COURT, by Representative J. Alexander, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 262**, PENALTIES FOR PROVIDING FALSE OR MISLEADING INFORMATION IN COURT with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 28 through 43:
- 28 (1) A person is guilty of a class B misdemeanor if the person, not under oath or
- 29 affirmation, intentionally or knowingly gives or causes to be given false or misleading
- 30 information to an officer of the court for the purpose of influencing a sentencing decision.
- 31 (2) For the purposes of this section "officer of the court" means:
- 32 (a) prosecutor;
- 33 <u>(b) judge;</u>
- 34 (c) court clerk;
- 35 [[<u>(d) attorney;</u>
- 36 (e) guardian ad litem; ]]
- 37 <u>(f) interpreter;</u>
- 38 (g) bailiff;
- 39 (h) presentence investigator;
- 40 (i) probation officer;
- 41 (j) parole officer; and
- 42 (k) any other person reasonably believed to be gathering sentencing information for the
- 43 court.
