Mr. Speaker:

The Transportation Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 322**, GOLF CARTS ALLOWED ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS, by Representative C. Moss, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 13 through 14:
 - allows a municipality or county to allow golf carts on specified highways under
 - 14 jurisdiction [[during daylight hours]];
- 2. Page 1, Line 20:
 - requires a golf cart used on the highway to be equipped with head lamps, stop lamps and brakes;
- 3. Page 8, Lines 236 through 238:
 - 236 (1) (a) In accordance with this section, a municipality or county may, by ordinance,
 - 237 <u>allow a golf cart to be operated on specified highways under its jurisdiction</u> [[<u>during</u> <u>daylight</u>
 - 238 <u>hours</u>]] .
- 4. Page 9, Lines 266 through 267:
 - 266 equipped with:
 - 267 (i) <u>head lamps</u>, tail lamps <u>and stop lamps</u>;
- 1. Page 9, Line 272:
 - 272 (v) [[braking for each wheel]] a braking system in compliance with the provisions of Section 41-6-145; and
