The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 73**, ESCAPE AMENDMENTS, by Senator T. Hatch, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Line 13:*

13 aids in the escape and is an employee or volunteer of specified government entities;

▶ defines the scope of activity considered to be an escape or attempted escape;

2. *Page 5, Lines 148 through 149:*

148 (iii) lawfully detained following arrest.

149 (b) "Escape" is considered to be a continuing activity commencing with the conception of the design to escape and continuing until the escaping prisoner is returned to official custody or the prisoner's attempt to escape is thwarted or abandoned.
