The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 132**, UTAH CONSTRUCTION TRADES LICENSING ACT - ELECTRICAL LICENSING AMENDMENTS, by Senator S. Jenkins, with the following amendments:

 - 104 master electrician, in effect immediately prior to May 3, 2004, is on and after May 3, 2004, 2004,
- 2. Page 4, Lines 108 through 111:

 (B) An individual who has less than four years of practical experience
 as a

 licensed apprentice
 under the
 - 109 <u>supervision of a licensed journeyman or master electrician prior to May 3, 2004, shall</u> <u>complete</u>
 - 110 the education requirements of Subsection (3)(c)(i)(A) [[-]] <u>or</u> (B), [[-(C), or (D)] to qualify for licensing
 - 111 <u>as a master</u> [[<u>residential</u>]] <u>electrician.</u>
