  - 312 [[<del>(i)</del>]] (A) that individual's name; and
  - 313 [[<u>(ii)</u>]] <u>(B)</u> that individual's:
  - 314 [[<del>(A)</del>]] <u>(I)</u> home address;
  - 315 [[<del>(B)</del>]] <u>(II)</u> home telephone number;
  - 316 [[<del>(C)</del>]] (III) Social Security number;
  - 317 [[<u>(D)</u>]] <u>(IV)</u> <u>birthdate; or</u>
  - 318 [[<u>(E)</u>]] <u>(V)</u> marital status ; and
    - (ii) this Subsection (1)(m) does not apply to:
    - (A) a record that must be disclosed in accordance with another statute; or
    - (B) a record that is otherwise classified and archived before June 1, 2004
