1. Page 1, line 13:                   delete "an instrumental landing system and"
2. Page 2, lines 28- 29:           reinstates "satisfies the following requirements:  
(1) the airport shall have an instrumental landing system;"
3. Page 2, line 30:                Before "has" insert "and (2) the airport"

**2. S.B. 93 Telecommunications Annual Report Amendments (B. Evans)**
