PUBLIC EDUCATION AMENDMENTS

Representative **Karen W. Morgan** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 46 through 53:*

46 (b) By May 1 of the year in which a State Board of Education member's term expires,
47 the lieutenant governor shall submit the name of each person who has filed a declaration of
48 candidacy for the State Board of Education to the nominating and recruiting committee for the
49 State Board of Education district in which the candidate resides .
50 (2) [(a)] By November 1 of [2003 and every four years thereafter] the year preceding
51 [[each regular general election year]] the year in which a State Board of Education member's term
expires , a nominating and recruiting committee consisting of [++] [[12]] eight
52 members, each to serve a [four-year] two-year term, shall be appointed by the governor as
53 follows for the district that member represents :
