23 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

24 Section 1. Section **23-19-10** is amended to read:

25 **23-19-10. Duplicate license, permit, tag, or certificate of registration.**

26 [~~Whenever any~~] If an unexpired license, permit, tag, or certificate of registration issued  
27 under the provisions of this code is destroyed, lost, or stolen, the Division of Wildlife



28 Resources ~~the~~ **and its authorized license agents** ~~may~~ ~~set fees and~~ ~~issue~~ a duplicate  
28a license [at a fee to be determined by the Wildlife  
29 Board. To obtain the duplicate license], permit, tag, or certificate of registration[, the applicant  
30 must complete an affidavit testifying to such loss, destruction or theft, and provide such other
