

Senator Howard A. Stephenson proposes the following substitute bill:

APPROPRIATION FOR PUBLIC EDUCATION

JOB ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM

2005 GENERAL SESSION

STATE OF UTAH

LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill appropriates money for the Public Education Job Enhancement Program.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ appropriates \$2,500,000 for the Public Education Job Enhancement Program; and
- ▶ provides that the money shall be used for:
 - signing bonuses to attract new mathematics, science, or information technology teachers; or
 - scholarships for teachers to cover tuition costs for a master's degree, endorsement, or graduate education in mathematics, science, or information technology.

Monies Appropriated in this Bill:

This bill appropriates \$2,500,000 to the State Board of Education.

Other Special Clauses:

This bill takes effect on July 1, 2005.

26 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

27 Section 1. **Appropriation for Public Education Job Enhancement Program.**

28 (1) There is appropriated from the Uniform School Fund for fiscal year 2005-06 only,
29 \$2,500,000 to the State Board of Education for the Public Education Job Enhancement
30 Program created in Section 53A-1a-601.

31 (2) The monies appropriated in Subsection (1):

32 (a) shall be used to provide:

33 (i) signing bonuses to attract new teachers who have at least a baccalaureate degree in
34 mathematics, physics, chemistry, physical science, or information technology; or

35 (ii) scholarships for teachers to cover tuition costs for a master's degree, an
36 endorsement, or graduate education in mathematics, physics, chemistry, physical science, or
37 information technology; and

38 (b) is nonlapsing.

39 Section 2. **Effective date.**

40 This bill takes effect on July 1, 2005.

The provisions of this bill appropriate \$2,500,000 to the State Board of Education in one-time Uniform School Fund revenues to support the Public Education Job Enhancement Program.
