

28 WHEREAS, Jade Pusey has been known as a man who dedicated his life to "protect
29 and serve" and had a great respect for individual constitutional rights;

30 WHEREAS, law enforcement personnel are among those who risk their lives to
31 selflessly serve each one of us and our communities;

32 WHEREAS, the citizens of Utah should be given the opportunity to recognize and offer
33 gratitude to law enforcement officers and their families, particularly in their time of dire need,
34 as a gesture of honor to their duty and sacrifice; and

35 WHEREAS, Jade Pusey valiantly battled a rare form of cancer called Desmoplastic
36 Small Round Cell Tumors, which took his life on January 29, 2005:

37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah
38 formally recognizes the dedicated service of Jade Pusey to the state of Utah, its citizens, and its
39 elected and appointed servants.

40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature expresses its condolences and
41 deepest sympathies to the family and friends of Jade Pusey.

42 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the family of
43 Jade Pusey.
