LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill limits the scope of the state's no-call database to unsolicited intrastate calls.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

► declares that unsolicited telephone calls made to a telephone number listed in the state's no-call database are violations only if they are intrastate calls.

AMENDS:

13-25a-108, as last amended by Chapter 263, Laws of Utah 2004

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **13-25a-108** is amended to read:

13-25a-108. Objections to telephone solicitations.

(1) A person may not make or cause to be made an unsolicited telephone call within Utah to a telephone number contained in the no-call database established under Section 13-25a-109.

(2) This section applies only to intrastate telemarketing.
