The Political Subdivisions Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 122**, BAIL BOND AMENDMENTS, by Representative K. Gibson, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 14 through 19:
 - 14 department {-;
 - 15 → establishes a fee to be collected at the jail on each bail bond written by a bail bond
 - 16 surety and directs the disposition of that fee; and
 - 17
 How directs a portion of that fee to the Departments of Insurance and Public Safety for
 - 18 paying the costs of the commission and for investigating and resolving bail bond
 - 19 complaints and conducting administrative investigations } .
