Mr. Speaker:

The Government Operations Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 369**, LOBBYIST REGULATION, by Representative J. Ferrin, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 13 through 14:
  - enacts the Lobbying Restrictions Act, which prohibits certain elected and appointed
  - government officials from acting as a lobbyist for { two years } one year after leaving office; and
- 2. Page 4, Lines 102 through 104:
  - (1) Except as provided in Subsection (2), a former state official may not become a
  - 103 <u>lobbyist or engage in lobbying activities for</u> { <u>two calendar years</u>} <u>one calendar</u> <u>year</u> , <u>beginning</u> <u>on</u> <u>the date the state</u>
  - 104 <u>official leaves office and ending on the</u> { <u>two-year</u> <u>one-year</u> <u>anniversary of that</u> <u>date.</u>
