Mr. President:

The Transportation and Public Utilities and Technology Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 134**, POWERSPORT VEHICLE FRANCHISE ACT, by Senator D. Eastman, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 7, Lines 208 through 213:*

208           (ii) if the order modifies or rejects a finding of fact in a recommendation from the  
209 advisory board, shall be made on the basis of information learned from the executive  
              director's:

210           (A) personal attendance at the hearing; **or**

211           (B) review of the record developed at the hearing {~~;~~**or**} .

212           {~~(C) consultation with the executive director's designee under Subsection~~  
213 ~~13-14-103(1)(a), who attended the adjudicative proceeding.~~}

2. *Page 9, Lines 263 through 267:*

263           (1) (a) A person may commence an adjudicative proceeding in accordance with this  
264 chapter and with Title 63, Chapter 46b, Administrative Procedures Act, to:

265           (i) remedy a violation of this chapter; [~~or~~]

266           (ii) obtain approval of an act regulated by this chapter[~~;~~];or

267           (iii) obtain any determination **that** this chapter specifically authorizes that  
person to request.
