H.B. 48 Motor Vehicle Registration and Safety Inspection Amendments (*Rep. B. Daw*)

Rep. Daw introduced H.B. 48 and explained it to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Alexander moved to amend the bill as follows.

1. Page 1, Lines 13 through 15:
