S.B. 114 County and Municipal Zoning Regarding Billboards (*Sen. M. Waddoups*)

H.B. 261 Motorboat Liability Insurance and Uninsured Motorist and Motorboat Identification Database Program Amendments (Rep. K. Gibson)

MOTION: Rep. Dougall moved to delete in title and body H. B. 261 and replace it with 1st Substitute H.B. 261. The motion passed unanimously.
