### 1. H.B. 47 New Automobile Franchise Act Amendments (S. Urquhart)

Rep. Urquhart explained the bill.

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Craig Bickmore, Director, Utah Auto Dealers Association, and Frank Pignanelli, Attorney, Alliance of Automobile Manufacturers, spoke in support of the bill.

**MOTION:** Sen. Walker moved to pass the bill out faorably.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen Mayne absent for the vote.

## 2. S.B. 167 Penalties for False Driver Licenses and Identification Cards (C. Walker)

MOTION: Sen. Walker moved to adopt 1st Sub. S.B. 167.
