1. *Page 2, Lines 30 through 32*

House Committee Amendments

2-7-2005:

- 30 • participation in a benefit plan that provides for reimbursement for medical
31 expenses using the remainder of unused sick leave hours at the employee's rate
32 of pay at the time of retirement but not less than the average rate of pay as for employees who retired in
the same state retirement system during the previous calendar year ;

2. *Page 7, Lines 192 through 195*

House Committee Amendments

2-7-2005:

- 192 (ii) participation in a benefit plan that provides for reimbursement for medical
193 expenses using monies deposited at the employee's rate of pay at the time of retirement.
194 (b) If the amount calculated under Subsection (2)(a)(i) exceeds the federal contribution
195 limitations, the amount representing the excess shall be deposited under Subsection (2)(a)(ii). =
(c) An employee's rate of pay at the time of retirement for purposes of Subsection (2)(a)(i) may
not be less than the average rate of pay of state employees who retired in the same retirement system
under Title 49, Utah State Retirement and Insurance Benefit Act, during the previous calendar year.
