Representative **Michael E. Noel** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 8, Lines 220 through 225:*

220 (C) the state favors quickly and effectively adjusting wildlife population goals and population
221 census
222 numbers in response to variations in the amount of available forage caused by drought or other
223 climatic adjustments, and ~~{that}~~ state agencies responsible for managing wildlife population
224 goals and population census numbers will give due regard to both the needs of the livestock
225 industry and the need to prevent the decline of species to a point where listing under the terms
of the Endangered Species Act when making such adjustments;

2. *Page 11, Lines 314 through 316:*

314 (ix) it is clearly demonstrated that the agency with management authority over the river
315 segment commits not to use an actual or proposed designation as a basis to impose Visual Resource
Management Class I or II management
316 prescriptions that do not comply with the provisions of Subsection (8)(t); and
