CHAPTER 48. TOXIC MOLD ACT

Part 1. General Provisions

26-48-101. Title.

This chapter is known as the "Toxic Mold Act."

Section 2. Section **26-48-102** is enacted to read:

26-48-102. Definitions.

As used in this chapter:

(1) "Department" means the Department of Health.

(2) (a) "Mold" means a form of multicellular fungi that live:

(i) on plant or animal matter; and

(ii) in indoor environments.

(b) "Mold" includes:

(i) cladosporium;

(ii) penicillium;

(iii) alternaria;

(iv) aspergillus;

(v) fuarium;

(vi) trichoderma;

(vii) memnoniella;

(viii) mucor; and

(ix) stachybotrys chartarum.

Section 3. Section **26-48-201** is enacted to read:

Part 2. Department Responsibilities**26-48-201. Department to provide public information.**

(1) The department shall ~~H~~→ [prepare] make available ~~←H~~ information concerning:

(a) the health impacts of mold on a person who occupies real property containing mold;

and

(b) recommended practices for a person who owns or occupies real property containing

mold.

(2) The department shall use any reasonable means to make the information ~~H~~→ [prepared]

available ~~←H~~

under Subsection (1) available and accessible to the public.
